Excursion to the National Park

There is a guided tour in the National Park offering a wonderful landscape and a lot of chances for animal watching. The tour is not too strenuous and therefore ideal for everybody. Special hiking shoes are not necessary however good gym shoes are recommended.

An English speaking guide leads this tour. The bus for this tour will leave at **6.30 a.m.** in Zuoz down at the gate to the Lyceum Alpinum close to the little chapel.

River Rafting

Costs: approx. 100.-- CHF (Rafting) + 38.-- CHF (train) (18.-- CHF half price abo)

The tour starts at 9.30 h a.m. in Scuol-Tarasp (station). The SWISSRAFT guide (<http://www.swissraft.ch/de/index.html>), who will accompany you on the trip, will pick you up. Included in the price: Instruction by the guide boat and equipment, transportation of your clothes from the start to the finish.

The tour will start at Zuoz station at 8.15 a.m. by train (or in case of availability of private cars by car at the same time). The ride to Scuol takes approx. one hour.

The conference secretary will organise the tickets on Monday, August 9. Please pick up and pay for your tour ticket (approx. 100,00 CHF) at the secretary's office on Monday after the last morning session. Without this ticket you cannot take part in the tour.

Since we were obliged to make definite reservations, it is necessary that you stick to your decision to take part in this tour after the ticket is bought. If you have to cancel your reservation for any reason, please try to find another person to take your place. Otherwise we are afraid that you will have to pay anyway.
